Appearance	Inky ruby and opaque almost black in the centre. Youthful and bright with a purple rim.
Nose	Just a little reserved but with hidden power showing beautiful violets, blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with a hint of white pepper and spice.
Palate	Perfectly balanced spiced plum and berry fruit with lovely ripe tannins. Velvety mouth feel, complex structure and a long savoury finish.
